Lamb Registration Change Details - 2026

As of January 1st 2026, the Wensleydale Longwool sheep Breeders' Association has made some slight adjustments to the tag ordering process. This affects lamb registrations and replacement tag orders for sheep that are already registered. If after reading this registration form you are at all confused about registering lambs or ordering replacement tags, please contact the secretary and she will be more than happy to help you. Below is a description of the below tag types and associated fees for lamb registrations.

Next Sequential WLSBA + EID (matching pair) - If you have not tagged your lambs with a ministry issued UK tag or have used slaughter tags in your lambs, you will require a next sequential pair of tags for each lamb, so please tick this option on the following page. If you have already tagged your lambs with a UK tag, please **do not** choose this option. This costs **£7 per lamb** and you will receive a WLSBA tag and matching EID. If you do not know your next sequential number, please leave the 'Individual Number' column blank and the secretary will sort this for you.

WLSBA Tag Only - If you have already tagged your lambs with a ministry issued UK EID tag and just want a single replica blue/orange WLSBA tag for the other ear, please tick this option. This costs **£7 per lamb** and you will receive a single WLSBA tag.

Replica WLSBA + EID (matching pair) - If you have already tagged your lambs with a ministry issued UK tag but would like to cut out the existing tags and replace them with matching pairs of WLSBA and EIDs for each lamb, please choose this option. This costs **£9.50 per lamb** and you will receive a matching set of replica WLSBA tags.

Management Tag - If you have already tagged your lambs with ministry issued UK tags and would like to insert a third tag into your lamb's ears, or if you are located in the Republic of Ireland, please choose this option. This costs **£7 per lamb** and you will receive a WLSBA management tag with only the pedigree number marked on the tag.

Please note that both membership fees and registration fees must be paid before stock can be registered and tags ordered.
